Though the defendant, [REDACTED], has managed to avoid the police and courts for quite some time, we want you to know that he hasn't been absent from our community, he's just gotten smarter about getting caught. His latest arrest causes us great concern.

This defendant's continuing return to our doorsteps, parking lots, and places of business has negatively impacted our customers' perceptions of their safety in the area we try to do business; their perception of the quality of our businesses; and as a result, has caused the loss of customers and subsequent revenue because of his repeated criminal trespassing.

Judge Wiehn, we pay our taxes, we support our families, and we obey the law. We need you to take seriously the impact of his crimes against our community and request that you consider the length of his criminal record, his affinity for our strip center, and then sentence the defendant accordingly.

We need this revolving door of abuse against us and our customers to stop.
